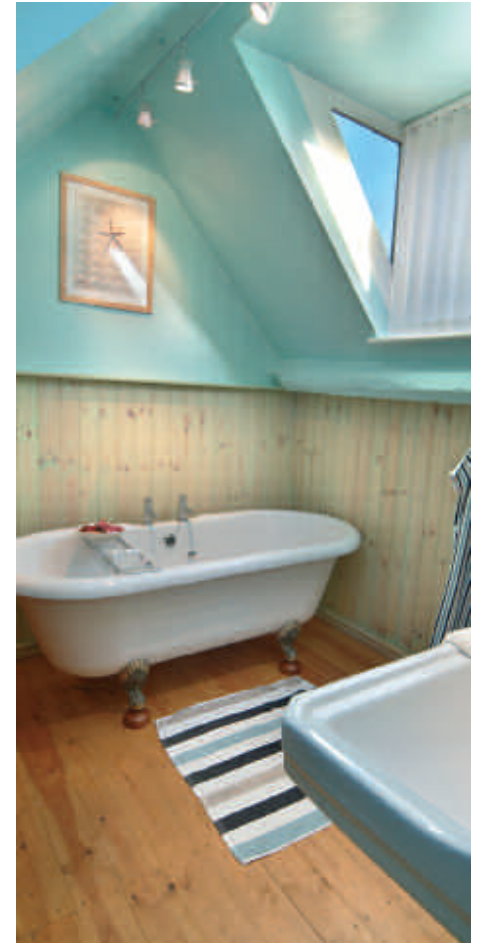
Discovery Cottage

Whitby and the Surrounding Area

Stroll through the pretty cobbled streets and narrow alleys, many dating from the medieval period with evocative names such as 'Flowergate' and 'Arguments Yard'. Walk down to the busy quayside with its mix of shops selling gourmet food, crafts, curios, souvenirs, antiques and original works of art.

For centuries, Whitby has provided a safe haven for shipping and fishing fleets. It was once the main whaling port for the North of England. Captain James

Cook sailed from the port to change the history of the world.

The town is steeped in history. From the old town, 199 steps lead up to the parish Church of St. Mary, dating from about 1210, which is one of the finest examples of Anglo Saxon churches in the country.

Whitby's skyline is dominated by Whitby Abbey high on the East Cliff. Adjacent is the recently opened Heritage Centre,

which houses archaeological material excavated at Whitby as well as computer generated images revealing how the headland has changed over time.

You can sample Whitby fish and chips from award winning restaurants, or enjoy a drink in one of Whitby's traditional cosy pubs.

There is so much to do. Children will be happy playing on the three mile stretch of sand which boasts a Blue Flag beach award, so is clean and safe. They will love looking for fossils on this 'dinosaur coast', where recent research has unearthed Jurassic dinosaur footprints. Alternatively you can just relax and watch the tide ebb and flow on the beautiful golden sands.

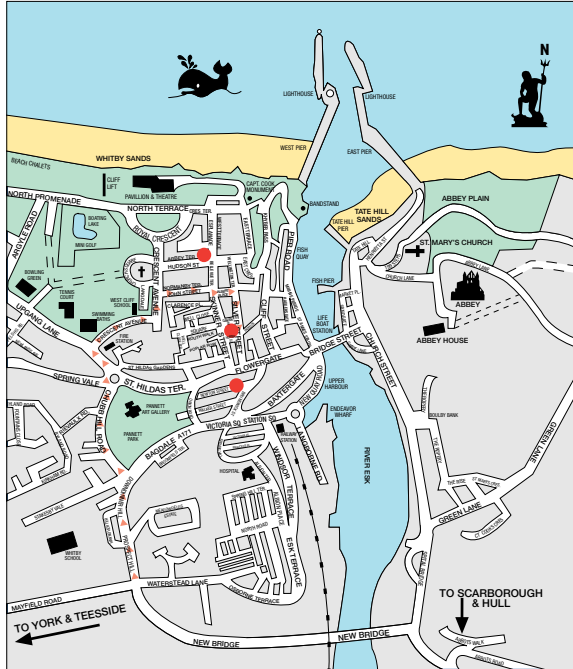
Further along the coastline you will discover Runswick Bay and Robin Hood's Bay – both are beautiful fishing villages with a unique character and links with smuggling and piracy.

The steam train from Goathland to Pickering travels through the scenic North York moors. You will recognise scenes used in the Harry Potter film. You can visit Goathland, made famous by 'Heartbeat'. Filming takes place for both 'Heartbeat' and 'The Royal' in Whitby and the surrounding area.








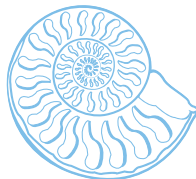
